**Jay Scott Berry -**

The Man behind the Mystery



Jay Scott Berry has been called a modern day Merlin and Renaissance man. He is an accomplished performer, inventor and teacher of magic. As such, he is recognized the world over as one of the leading architects of the artform.

For over 20 years, Jay has traveled the globe, delighting audiences with a style of illusion that goes beyond mere deception to pure inspiration. From intimate close-up magic to spectacular stage illusions, he is a magician's magician; a master in his field.

Jay is also an accomplished composer and musician. Among his musical achievements are four acclaimed instrumental CDs. Initially creating soundtracks for his own performances, Jay developed a unique musical style that is as breathtaking and beautiful as his magic.

Jay has performed thousands of shows, from Las Vegas to Monte Carlo, New York to Paris; from the Grand Ballroom of the Beverly Hilton to the historic Theatre-an-der-Wien in Vienna. He's been featured on dozens of national, and international television programs.

As one of the pre-eminent creators of original magic effects, Jay is in constant demand throughout the world as a lecturer and seminar leader. He has collaborated on numerous film, television and theatrical productions, working alongside the likes of Walt Disney's Imagineers, Alan Parsons, Anthony Robbins, Muhammed Ali, Jon Anderson and Jim Stafford. His creative, motivational style is in constant demand at corporate events and trade shows. Over the years, Jay's diverse range of clients include such names as Apple, Nissan, Ford, BASF, AMD, and Capitol Records.

One of the most exciting projects Jay is currently involved with is The Palace of Magic Festival, held in and around the spectacular Royal Palace in Falkland, Scotland. In August, 2002, the first Festival took place, and Jay was honoured to be one of the headline performers. It proved such a success that it was made an annual event, and Jay, with his diverse range of talents, was invited to join the production team. Now in it's third year, The Palace of Magic is fast becoming the largest international Festival of Magic.
