Maverick was first

attracted to the art of magic at the age of eleven when a magic shop opened not far from his home in Cincinnati, Ohio. Once Maverick stepped inside the doors of the shop, he knew what he wanted to be when he grew up.

The owner of the shop, LMC's friend Bill Brewere, took Maverick under his wing, and soon had him entered in many junior magic competitions where he took first place on many occasions.

In 1982 Maverick enrolled at the Chavez College of Manual Dexterity and Prestidigitation, under the tutelage of Neil Foster, the only school of its kind in the world. After graduating, Maverick went on to win many magic awards, including his achievement of World Champion Magician.

Maverick has continued his career by performing in over 50 countries around the world. From the "Crazy Girls" revue at the Tokyo Hilton to the world-renowned Magic Castle in Hollywood, California. Maverick's style, personality and presentation set him apart as he truly turns tricks into magic.

Maverick's television appearances have included NBC Nightly News, Nippon-Hoso-Kyoka (NHK), Tokyo, Japan and the Masters of Illusion series featured on the NBC network.

So, treat yourself and your friends to a gala, magical world for a few moments with one of magic's fastest rising stars – he'll only be here for one night. The cost and meal are also great treats.
