Tim Ellis is known throughout the world for his original, innovative and highly entertaining approach to the art of magic. He performs hundreds of shows every year for corporations and at private events all over the globe.

In the 80's and 90's he created and produced 'Magic Week', Australia's National Festival of the Magical Arts.

For 5 years he owned and operated Melbourne's legendary 'Bernard's Magic Shop', and during this time he produced a series of 18 magic-teaching videos, as well as his own innovative tutorial tape 'Cunning Stunts'.

After winning virtually every award Australian magic had to offer including 'Best Stage Magician' and 'Best Close Up Magician', Tim became the first Australian ever to win twice at the FISM 'World Championship of Magic' - Switzerland in 1991 and Japan in 1994.

In 2001 Tim and Sue-Anne teamed up to present their magic lectures through the USA and Europe. In 2001 they were voted 'Most Valuable Participants' at the prestigious 'FFFF Convention' for Close-Up Magic.
